

A RESOLUTION CALLING A HEARING FOR CONSIDERATION OF
TERMINATING THE SEWER SERVICE OF DISCHARGERS THAT HAVE NOT
PAID NON-DOMESTIC WASTE SOURCE CONTROL PROGRAM PERMIT FEES
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2002-2003

RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside, San Mateo County, California, as follows:

WHEREAS, this Board did, by its Resolution No. 1-91, adopt regulations establishing a Non-Domestic Waste Source Control Program (“the Program”);

WHEREAS, this Board did, by its Resolution No. 2-94, amend the regulations establishing the Program, thereby establishing the amended regulations now in effect (“the Regulations”);

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 3.10 of the Regulations states that the Authority is authorized to establish a uniform schedule of fees to cover the cost of issuing permits and insure that the conditions of the permits is complied with;

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 3.11 of the Regulations states that the Authority is authorized to collect such fees;

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 3.12 of the Regulations states that the Authority is allowed to assess a penalty for delinquent payment;

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 3.0 of the Regulations states that it is unlawful to discharge non-domestic wastewater into the sanitary sewer without first obtaining a Permit from the Authority and that the Permit will not be issued until all applicable fees are paid;

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 5.6 of the Regulations states that the Authority may terminate sanitary sewer services to any premises from which waste is being discharged in violation of any provisions of the Regulations;

WHEREAS, the Authority did by its Resolution 9-2002, adopt a uniform schedule of fees for use in conjunction with the Program for Fiscal Year 2002-2003 (“Program Fees”);

WHEREAS, there are certain dischargers, required to pay Program Fees, that have failed to do so even after receiving a reminder notice and late notice from the Authority (“Subject Dischargers”);

WHEREAS, all Subject Dischargers and Subject Discharger property owners, have been noticed of the time and place of a hearing at which this Board would consider enforcement action against dischargers failing to pay Program Fees;

WHEREAS, this Board at such hearing duly considered information presented by staff regarding the failure of Subject Dischargers to pay Program Fees;

WHEREAS, the Subject Dischargers that have not paid Program Fees as of this Public Hearing date of November 24, 2003 are:

The Anchorage Restaurant
Highway One Diner

NOW THEREFORE, it is determined and ordered that the Sewer Service of the above listed subject dischargers be terminated within 31 days, from date and signature of this Resolution, (November 24, 2003), unless the Non Domestic Waste Source Control Program Permit Fees for FY 2002-2003 and late penalties applicable, are submitted by above listed subject dischargers to the Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside no later than December 26, 2003.


