A RESOLUTION APPROVING LOCAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN
ANNEX

RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside, San Mateo County, California, as follows:

WHEREAS, the Bay Area is subject to various earthquake-related hazards such as ground shaking, liquefaction, fault surface rapture, and tsunamis; and

WHEREAS, the Bay Area is subject to various weather-related hazards including wildfires, floods, and landslides; and

WHEREAS, Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside recognizes that disasters do not recognize city, county, or special district boundaries; and

WHEREAS, Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside seeks to maintain and enhance both a disaster-resistant County of San Mateo and region by reducing the potential loss of life, property damage, and environmental degradation from natural disasters, while accelerating economic recovery from those disasters; and

WHEREAS, Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside is committed to increasing the disaster resistance of the infrastructure, health, economy, government services, and environment in the County of San Mateo, as well as in the Bay Area as a whole; and

WHEREAS, the federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 requires all cities, counties, and special districts to have adopted a Local Hazard Mitigation Plan to receive disaster mitigation funding from FEMA; and

WHEREAS, ABAG has approved and adopted the ABAG report Taming Natural Disasters as the multi-jurisdictional Local Hazard Mitigation Plan for the San Francisco Bay Area.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside adopts this Local Hazard Mitigation Plan Annex.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside commits to continuing to take those actions and initiating future actions, as appropriate, as identified in the Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside's Annex of that Local Hazard Mitigation Plan.


