Resolution No. 2 - 2012

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE ASSOCIATION OF BAY AREA GOVERNMENTS MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN "TAMING NATURAL DISASTERS" AS THE SEWER AUTHORITY MID-COASTSIDE LOCAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Bay Area is subject to various earthquake-related hazards such as ground shaking, liquefaction, land sliding, fault surface rupture, and tsunamis; and

WHEREAS, the Bay Area is subject to various weather-related hazards including wildfires, floods, and landslides; and

WHEREAS, the Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside recognizes that disasters do not recognize city, county, or special district boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside seeks to maintain and enhance both a disaster-resistant Agency and region by reducing the potential loss of life, property damage, and environmental degradation from natural disasters, while accelerating economic recovery from those disasters; and

WHEREAS, the Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside is committed to increasing the disaster resistance of the infrastructure, health, housing, economy, government services, education, environment, and land use systems in SAM, as well as in the Bay Area as a whole; and

WHEREAS, the federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (Act) requires all cities, counties, and special districts to adopt a Local Hazard Mitigation Plan to receive disaster mitigation funding from FEMA; and

WHEREAS, ABAG has approved and adopted the ABAG report *Taming Natural Disasters*, created in collaboration with the participating jurisdictions, as the multi-jurisdictional Local Hazard Mitigation Plan for the San Francisco Bay Area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside adopts, and adapts with its local annex, this multi-jurisdictional plan as its Local Hazard Mitigation Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside commits to continuing to take those actions and initiating further actions, as appropriate, as identified in the Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside Annex of that multi-jurisdictional Local Hazard Mitigation Plan.


